considerable amount of loss to human lives and economies yet the spirit and morals of the J.M.P.S family could not be broken and disheartened.

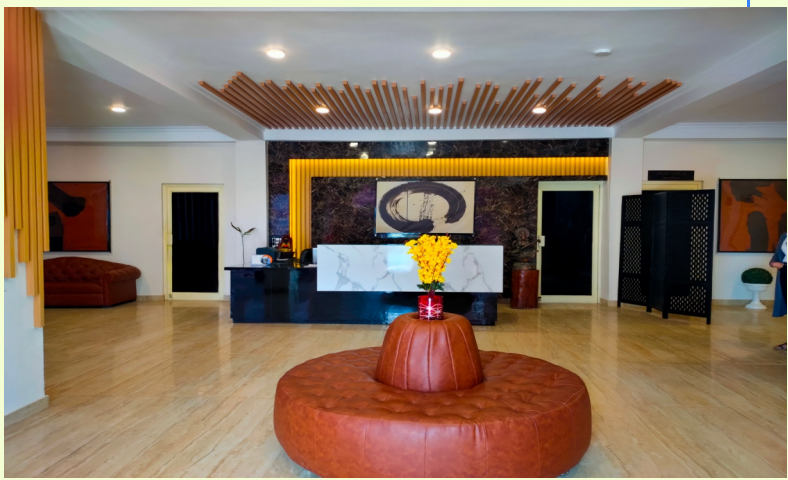


The J.M.P.S family boldly faced all challenges and gained victory over the evil.

The JMPS family is dejected at the loss of the parents, close relatives and friends

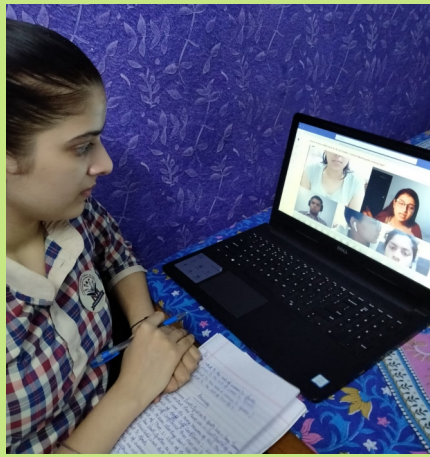

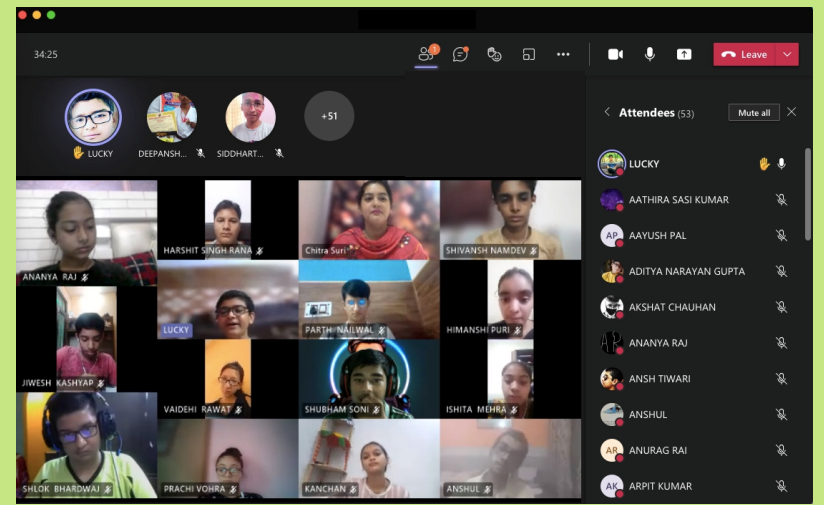
The rapidly escalating viral crisis that closed schools and various other

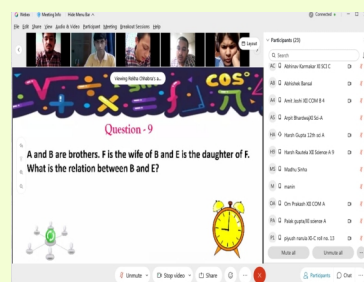
Experiential Learning
